I Sam 8:4-5 Then all the elders of Israel gathered together and came to Samuel at Ramah; <sup>5</sup>and they said to him, "Behold, you have grown old, and your sons do not walk in your ways. Now appoint a king for us to judge us like all the nations."

I Sam 8:7-9 The LORD said to Samuel, "Listen to the voice of the people in regard to all that they say to you, for they have not rejected you, but they have rejected Me from being king over them. <sup>8</sup>Like all the deeds which they have done since the day that I brought them up from Egypt even to this day--in that they have forsaken Me and served other gods--so they are doing to you also. <sup>9</sup>Now then, listen to their voice; however, you shall solemnly warn them and tell them of the procedure of the king who will reign over them."

I Sam 8:10-18 So Samuel spoke all the words of the LORD to the people who had asked of him a king. <sup>11</sup>He said, "This will be the procedure of the king who will reign over you: he will <u>take your sons</u> and place them for himself in his chariots and among his horsemen and they will run before his chariots. <sup>12</sup>He will appoint for himself commanders of thousands and of fifties, and some to do his plowing and to reap his harvest and to make his weapons of war and equipment for his chariots. <sup>13</sup>He will also <u>take your daughters</u> for perfumers and cooks and bakers. <sup>14</sup>He will <u>take the best of your fields and your vineyards</u> and your olive groves and give them to his servants. <sup>15</sup>He will <u>take a tenth of your seed</u> and of your vineyards and your female servants and your best young men and your donkeys and use them for his work. <sup>17</sup>He will take a tenth of your flocks, and you yourselves will become his

<u>servants</u>. <sup>18</sup>Then you will cry out in that day because of your king whom you have chosen for yourselves, but the LORD will not answer you in that day."

Mt 11:29-30 Jesus said, "Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and YOU WILL FIND REST FOR YOUR SOULS. <sup>30</sup>"For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

I Sam 8:19-22 Nevertheless, the people refused to listen to the voice of Samuel, and they said, "No, but there shall be a king over us, <sup>20</sup>that we also may be like all the nations, that our king may judge us and go out before us and fight our battles." <sup>21</sup>Now after Samuel had heard all the words of the people, he repeated them in the LORD'S hearing. <sup>22</sup>The LORD said to Samuel, "Listen to their voice and appoint them a king." So Samuel said to the men of Israel, "Go every man to his city."
